CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 2S) through drilled well, pump and stock tanks for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 21 bears S. 43 degrees 53' W., a distance of 1,853.7 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 6, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and conveyed to three 2 foot x 10 foot stock tanks where it is used to water approximately 2,000 head of cattle within the E 1/4 Section 21, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
