CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Boyd N. Rucker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, storage tank, & watering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 25 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 24, T. 25 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 81 degrees 36'38" E., a distance of 7,880.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 28, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed to a 7,000 gallon tank where it is used to water approximately 600 head of cattle within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 25 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
