CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS David P. McConnell (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well and pump for mining

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 13, T. 12 N., R. 21 E., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 13 bears S. 8 degrees 10' W., a distance of 4,650.0 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a 4-inch pipe to ponds where it is used for mining within Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13 and 24, all in T. 12 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
