CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and stock tank for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 33 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 16 bears N. 47 degrees 03' E., a distance of 1,583 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed to a 500 gallon stock tank where it is used for watering approximately 240 head of cattle and 3 horses within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 33 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
