CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 26 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 of said Sec. 28 bears S. 88 degrees 25' W., a distance of 2,570.27 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* Amount of appropriation 2.7 c.f.s., but not to exceed 640 acre-feet Per season

Period of use, from April 15 to December 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 4, 1964

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 160 acres in the NW 1/4 of Section 28, T. 22 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.

\* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
