CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Juanita T. Smith (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, storage tank and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 15 bears S. 44 degrees 56' 13" E., a distance of 1,928.0 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to an elevated 75,000 gallon tank where it is used by the City of Yerington for municipal use within W 1/2 Sec. 14, S 1/2 NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 Section 15; E 1/2 NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 Section 22; NE 1/4 Section 23, all in T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
