

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. R. Burch (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & distribution system for mining & milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 4, T.13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 4 bears S. 56 degrees 12' 24" E., a distance of 6082.62 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 404.38 mg annually  
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation March 21, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed through 1100 feet of 12 inch pipe & 2800 feet of 14 inch pipe into a reservoir, thence into a 1.5 mg tank for distribution. It is used for concentrating & leaching copper ore located within portions of Sections 8, 16 & 17, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
