

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Karl F. Weikel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, storage tank and stockwatering troughs for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 28S., R. 62E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 22 bears S. 55° 05' 10" W. a distance of 1,238.5 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02228 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 614 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 2, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped into a 550 gallon pressure tank for the ranch headquarters and into 45,000 gallon storage tanks, thence to 7 watering troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 600 head of cattle and 14 horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
