CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry D. Ott has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well pump & distribution system for mining & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 34, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 34 bears S 88° 19' W a distance of 680.2 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.267 c.f.s. but not to exceed 193.2 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 1st, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well thence pumped via 4"x40' pipe line where a water truck with a 500 gallon tank transports the water to the place of use located within portions of Sections 23, 24, 26 & 34, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M. and used for sluicing and sampling mining operation

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
