CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E. L. Spencer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well and pipelines for milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 28 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 12° 14' 30" E., a distance of 2,086.72 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.31 c.f.s., but not to exceed 73.1 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 22, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped through 200 feet of 4 and 240 feet of 3 inch pipelines to the plant area located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 28 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for dust recovery and control and waste disposal purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
