CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 31 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M, or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 36 bears N. 44 degrees 33' W., a distance of 70.0 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Jerry L. Stallings
Post-office address: Beaverton, Oregon
Amount of appropriation: 5.4 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1248.52 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 26, 1967

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 7 columns: Acres, Section, Township, Range, Meridian, and other identifiers. Rows include 37.90 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36, T. 31 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., and various other sections totaling 312.13 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
