CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Holden (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Galena Spring through storage tank and pipelines for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of Sec. 9, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 14° E. a distance of 3345 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Goldfield Concentrate Corp.
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.1506 c.f.s. but not to exceed 35.527 m.g. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 3, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring and pumped thru 2" pipe to a 26,000-gallon storage tank and fed by gravity thru 2" pipe to the mill, assay office and campsite within the S 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9 and the N 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16, all in T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the water being discharged into Duck Creek or any other source shall be undiminished and uncontaminated in quality.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
