CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Holden (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Shiloh Shaft through Shaft, pumps, storage tanks & distribution system for milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 19° E., a distance of 2460 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.716 c.f.s. but not to exceed 268,908 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 3, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from an existing shaft and is pumped to 2-3,000 gallon storage tanks where it is piped to the mill within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the water being discharged into Duck Creek or any other source shall be undiminished and uncontaminated in quality.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
