CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. LeRoy Givens - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & distribution system for Quasi-municipal (resort hotel) & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4, NW 1/4, Sec. 28, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW 1/4 corner of said Sec. 28 bears N. 42° 06' 07" W. a distance of 1459.62 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Hotel Conquistador, Inc.
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.30 c.f.s. but not to exceed 119.30 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 11, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in the well thence conveyed via pipeline to storage facility then distributed to the hotel water system located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit. This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner & place of use of permit 13444, Certificate 4950, hence the date of priority remains the same as permit 13444, Certificate 4950.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
