

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Sterling C. Ditsworth - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, storage tanks and distribution system for quasi - municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 19 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 31 bears N. 59 degrees 52' 18" W., a distance of 1191 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kyle Canyon Utilities, Inc.
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
* Amount of appropriation: 0.367 c.f.s., but not to exceed 27.86 mg annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 18, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in a well, thence pumped to two storage tanks of 125,000 & 80,000 gallon capacity, thence through a distribution system to 53 homes located within the N 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 19 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., and used for quasi-municipal purposes.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the combined diversion granted in this certificate and that granted under Permit 20437 shall not exceed 0.367 c.f.s.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
