CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Johann Hetzel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE through drilled well, pump, tank and distribution system for quasi-municipal (subdivision) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Sec. 20, bears N. 50 degrees 56' 47" W., a distance of 668.48 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.04 c.f.s., but not to exceed 30 acre-feet annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

** Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a distribution system to 4 houses, 3 apartments and 2 house trailers within the E 1/2 E 1/2 W 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

** This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit 13153, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit 13153.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
