CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Filippini Spring No. 2 through ditch, pipe and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 30 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of Sec. 12, T. 30 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 32 degrees 18' E., a distance of 5,186 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chapter 140, Stat. 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Half Circle Cattle Co., Inc.
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
* Amount of appropriation: 0.0218 cfs, or sufficient to water 600 cattle or 100 horses
Period of use, from: March 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 27, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring where it is ponded and conveyed by a pipe to a watering trough where it is used to water approximately 600 head of cattle and 100 horses within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 30 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B. & M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
