CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Rev. Thomas J. Connally has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 23 bears S. 8 degrees 35' 43" E., a distance of 1,422.56 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.0588 cfs, but not to exceed 13.87 mg annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 13, 1970

Description of work of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through 100 feet of 1 1/2" pipe to a building used for religious instruction within portions of the NE 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
