CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, storage tanks & distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 19 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 29 bears N 63° 46' W. 4014 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Lander County Combined Sewer & Water Dist. No. 2

Name of appropriator: General Improvement District
Post-office address: Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.04 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 2, 1970

Description of work of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed thru a chlorinator and 3" transmission line to 1-150,000 gallon and 2-40,000 gallon storage tanks and then thru a series of 6" to 1" distribution lines for use by the town of Austin within portions of Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30 all in T. 19 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
