CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. S. Leighton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Poplar St. #2) through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 8 bears N. 12° 27' 23" E., a distance of 2235.0 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.9 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 10, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed to the Reno-Sparks distribution mains for distribution within the S 1/2 Sec. 32, S 1/2 Sec. 33, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. and used for municipal purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
