CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Duval Well No. 2) through drilled well, pump and distribution system for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 30N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 4, T. 30N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 10° 25' W. a distance of 10,501.8 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.88 c.f.s. but not to exceed 679.4 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 10, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed by means of 10-inch and 12-inch pipeline to a 40,000 gallon tank from where it is then pumped through a 10-inch pipeline to a 40,000 gallon storage tank from where it is distributed to the place of use within Sections 21, 22, 27, 28, 33 & 34 T. 31N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
