

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lawrence E. Settlemeier has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from East Fork Carson River through diversion canal, pumps and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 24, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 24 bears S. 19° 19' W. a distance of 919.8 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.56 c.f.s. but not to exceed 200.0 acre feet per season
Period of use, from March 15th to October 15th of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation As decreed

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

Table with 5 columns: Acres, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4. Total acres 35,312.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season from any and all sources.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of water heretofore appropriated under the proposed Carson River Decree, No. D-183, hence the priority of appropriation is as decreed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
