CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and stock troughs for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 22, T.35N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 22 bears N. 38° 51' W. a distance of 215.82 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.04456 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 360 head of cattle
Period of use, from April 15th to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 18, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped through 1 inch pipeline to an 18 inch by 20 feet long stock trough located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.35N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 360 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
