CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS H. R. Burch (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 13N, R. 25E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 5 bears N. 56° 09' 00" E. a distance of 3,364.33 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Anaconda Company
Post-office address: Weed Heights, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.23 c.f.s, but not to exceed 526.0 m.g. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 7, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is developed in the well, thence pumped via 4100' of 12" and 2800' of 14" pipeline to a gathering reservoir, thence into a 1.5 million gallon tank and is used to process oxide or sulphide ore located within Sections 8, 16 and 17 T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
