CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E. W. Thorne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Appaloosa Spring through open cut for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 21 S., R. 56 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 43° 30' W. a distance of 3560 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 00031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 10 head of horses
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 20, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an open cut 30 feet long, 6 feet wide and from 0 to 10 feet in depth, in the spring area. It is used to water 10 horses and located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19 T. 21 S., R. 56 E., M. D. B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
