CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an abandoned mining tunnel through dam, pipeline and tank for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 31N., R. 43E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 11 bears S. 36° 51' W. a distance of 1,602.0 feet.

situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.00223 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,440 g.p.d.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 20, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from mine tunnel by a small earthen dam thence conveyed through 700 feet of 1 inch plastic pipe to a 50 gallon storage tank located at the place of use within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
