CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Electric #2) through well, pump and pipeline stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 7N., R. 66E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of Sec. 4, T. 6N., R. 66E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 6° 37' W. a distance of 1656.10 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 27, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump, and motor, and thence conveyed through 16 feet of 4 inch I.D. pipe to a steel stockwatering tank 25 feet in diameter and 27 inches deep, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
