CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, HENRY C. Conrad - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 25N., R. 42E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 28 bears S. 44° 38' E. a distance of 141.42 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

*This certificate changes the place of use of waters heretofore appropriated under Permit 22167 which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 19295, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 19295.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
