

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cow Canyon through 2" steel pipe for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 11, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 11 bears N. 34° 18' W., a distance of 601 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 per annum, January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Period of use, from May 20, 1968

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
5 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 11, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M.
5 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
