CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from North Creek and Sheep Creek through creek, headgate and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 28, T.10N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 35 T.10N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 48° 12' E. a distance of 14,545.0 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0954 c.f.s. but not to exceed 32.4 acre feet per season
Period of use, from April 15th to November 15th of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation April 17, 1912

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
10.8 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 6, T.9N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 2410, Certificate 5278, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit 2410.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
