CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Carlson Spring through plastic pipe and ditches for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 39 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 5 bears East, a distance of 1980 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Robert E. Marble and Peter E. Marble
Post-office address Deeth, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0624 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2,000 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 18, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from the spring and a portion is allowed to flow through 250 feet of 1 1/2" pipe to a cabin for domestic purposes. The remainder flows through ditches located within Lots 3 and 4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, E 1/2 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 5, T. 39 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used for stockwatering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
