CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Edwin L. DePaoli has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 32 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 16 bears S 54° 37' 27" W., a distance of 1,484.0 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.12 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1800 gallons per day
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 15, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed to a 250 gallon storage tank, thence conveyed to a trailer residency and watering trough in a corral located within the SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 32 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M. and used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
