CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Eugene B. Wolpert, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Long Canyon Creek and underground through dam, ditch, pipeline and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 7, T. 15 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 31, T. 16 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N 10° 33' E., a distance of 5,930.0 feet. Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937 ~~NRS 531.225~~ has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0221 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 750 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 8, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the creek by a small rock dam, thence conveyed by a ditch to a sump, thence by pipeline to a 15' by 2' by 2' metal trough, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 750 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
