CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ben Colvin - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Yellow Tiger Tunnel through mine tunnel, pipeline and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 5 S., R. 44 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of T. 4 S., R. 44 E., M. D. B. & M. bears N. 41° 40' E., a distance of 6,000.0 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.003125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 3, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from the mine tunnel thence conveyed through 200 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to two, 200 gallon troughs, located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2, T. 5 S., R. 44 E., M. D. B. & M., where it is used to water 100 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
