CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 21 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 2 T. 21 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N 08° 56' 39" W., a distance of 16,144.37 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 5.3 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1192.8 acre-feet per annum.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation July 6, 1965

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 8 columns: Area, and 7 columns for section descriptions (NW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4). Total area 298.20 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of waters heretofore appropriated under Permit 22677, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as that of Permit 22677.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
