CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. Douglas Miller has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through pipe line, storage tank and distribution system for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T.11N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 26° 04' W. a distance of 4,284.0 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., but not to exceed 8.05 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 12, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is developed at the spring thence conveyed to a storage tank thence via gravity to a rod and ball mill. Another portion is pumped to the mine entrance and used in the drilling operation and a portion is diverted to the camp site adjacent to the mill and used for domestic purposes located within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T.11N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
