CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

unnamed springs through perforated pipe and storage tank for mining, milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 36, T.16N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 36 bears S. 53° 41' 21" E. a distance of 2,705.3 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Best Chance Mining Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00446 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.052 m.g.a.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 14, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a 4" perforated pipe thence carried by 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to a 500 gallon storage tank within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T.16N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining, milling, and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
