CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edwin E. Caine - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Springs through pipeline and tanks for locomotive and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 8, SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T.36N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 21 T.36N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 8° 22' 11" W. a distance of 12,745.13 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of ~~NRS 523.426~~ Sec. 29, Ch. 18, Statutes of 1907 source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Western Pacific Railroad Company
Post-office address: San Francisco, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.3 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 6, 1911

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is collected by a small concrete dam thence conveyed 2,450 feet by 4 inch wooden pipe, thence 4,700 feet by five inch wooden pipe, thence 2100 feet to a concrete well, thence 6500 feet by 8 inch wooden pipe, thence 23,500 feet by 8 inch metal pipe, thence 36,500 feet by 6 inch metal pipe, thence 20,000 feet by 6 inch wooden pipe to a concrete reservoir within Section 34, T.1N., R.19W., S.L.B.&M., thence 20,300 feet to the Town of Wendover, Utah where it is used for locomotive and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
