CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr. - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 45 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 11 bears S. 47° 18' E., a distance of 2,566.3 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bengoa Ranching Co., Inc.
Post-office address: Orovada, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 4.695 cfs, but not to exceed 1179.2 acre-feet per year
Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation January 31, 1961

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
