CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard McKay has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Cougar Spring through Spring, pipe and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 14 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 89° 08' W., a distance of 2,410.0 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Richard W. and Anna McKay

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
0.0046 cfs, or sufficient to water

Amount of appropriation 150 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 15th to October 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 18, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the spring through 30 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to a 20 foot stock trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 150 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
