CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald C. Long, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Ebbley tunnel) through drilled shaft, pumps & pipeline for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 33 T. 2 S., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., bears S.84°30'E., a distance of 7,820.0 ft. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Name of appropriator Mid-Continent Uranium Corp.  
Post-office address Kellogg, Idaho  
Amount of appropriation 0.25 cfs, but not to exceed 181.0 acre-feet per annum  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use  
water is developed in a mine tunnel thence conveyed via a 1' x 2" wide ditch 1150' to mine tunnel portal. Thence conveyed via a 1 inch pipe to county road for domestic purposes. Water is used in the tunnel for mining purposes located within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
