source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.000556 cfs or sufficient to water 35 head of cattle and horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 27, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from spring thence piped through 50 feet of 1-inch pipe to a 1000 gallon storage tank thence through 25 feet of pipe to a 2' x 2' x 15' trough within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
