CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert G. Irvin - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Coyote Spring through spring, pipe and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 24 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 1 bears N 14° E., a distance of 1,434.0 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Sec. 72, Ch. 140, Statutes of 1913 NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of ~~NRS 533.022~~ has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: C - Punch Corporation
Post-office address: Los Angeles, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 17, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted at the spring by a box, thence piped 150 feet to a metal trough located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 24 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used to water 300 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
