CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph W. Whittle - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Queen Spring #1, 2, and 3 through Collection Box, Pipeline, Reservoir, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T.1N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 21, T.1N., R.32E., bears: Spring #1, S. 29° 10' E., 9,364.0 feet; Spring No.2, S. 28° 58' E., 9,367.0 feet; Spring #3, S. 28° 51' E., 9,345.0 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Name of appropriator: Wales G. Bramlette
Post-office address: Benton, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.0217 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.40 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 12, 1963

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 1.10 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T.1N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per annum from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
