CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. L. Higginbotham (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 18 bears S. 19° 11' 36" W. a distance of 1,386.88 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address North Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 16.3 m.g. per annum

\* Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 16, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed via pipeline to storage tanks, thence via a distribution system to the service area in the City of North Las Vegas where it is used for municipal purposes.

\* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit. This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 19230, Certificate 6428, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 12504, Certificate 3655, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit 12504, Certificate 3655.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
