CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. LeRoy Givens - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and sprinkler system for Recreation (irrigation of golf course) and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 16 bears N 37° 39' W., a distance of 1430.0 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Desert Inn Improvement Company
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.292 c.f.s., but not to exceed 68.88 mqa
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation: August 19, 1944

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 4 columns: Area (acres), Section, Township, Range. Rows include 34.4 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 28.1 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 26.7 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 31.9 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, and a total of 121.1 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 11156, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as that of Permit 11156.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
