CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harold R. Knight has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 31, T. 26 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said section 31 bears N. 19° 05' E., a distance of 1,644.8 feet.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 8, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in a tunnel 5' x 5' x 15' and dammed by a 5' x 4' cement dam thence via a 1" x 170' pipe line to a cement trough 2' x 3' x 12' and used to water cattle located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
