CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 14 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said section 24 bears N. 58° 39' E., a distance of 3,244.07 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Baker, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.022 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.46 mga

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 1, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and motor, thence conveyed through 100 feet of pipe to a pressure tank thence through a distribution system to a small motel, cafe, bar and service station complex located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
