CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Grant A. Engstrom (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Indian Seed Spring through diversion box ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T. 18 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 7 bears N 38° 20' E., a distance of 3729.0 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
