CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and stockwatering tank for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T.6N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 1 bears N. 73° 02' E., a distance of 4,633.95 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 6, 1967

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is developed in a 10" dia. by 220 feet deep well, thence pumped through 35 feet of 3 1/2" pipe by either a windmill or a gasoline engine to a 25 feet diameter by 2 deep tank located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
